

Sample collection for detecting occult blood in the stool (F -hHb,6455)

Sample collection equipment

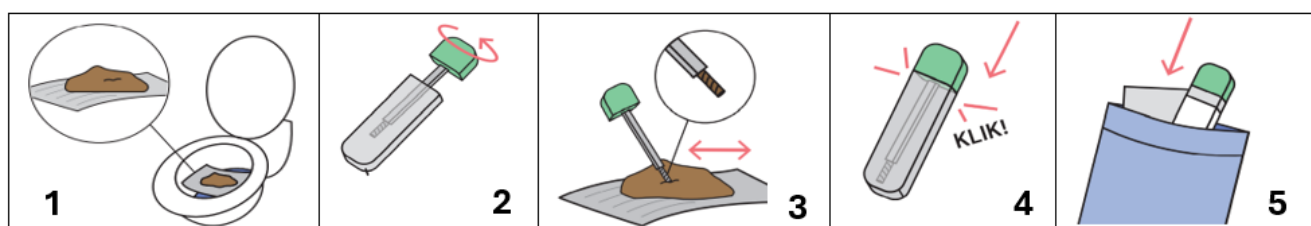
- Sample tube (green cap)
- Plastic bag with an absorbent pad
- You will also need a newspaper, a disposable plate or other clean and dry surface to pass stool onto.

If the doctor has requested for more than one sample, you will receive a corresponding number of sample kits. In this case, the samples must be collected on different days or at least during separate bowel movements. Each sample must be collected in a separate tube, and the date of the sampling must be written on each tube.

Collecting sample

1. Pass stool onto a clean and dry surface, such as a newspaper or a disposable plate. Avoid getting urine mixed in with the stool sample.
2. Open the sample tube by unscrewing the green cap. Do not break the tinfoil film at the bottom of the tube.
3. Collect stool onto the tip of the sampling stick attached to the cap. Swipe the stick back and forth in the stool in several different spots. You can stop when the stick's spiral tip is covered in stool (see the circled image). Too much stool in the sample tube can lead to a faulty result.
4. Put the cap stick first into the sample tube. Do not break the tinfoil film at the bottom of the tube. Close the cap carefully by pressing it down until you hear a clicking sound. Do not open the cap anymore.
5. Put the sample tube in a plastic bag. There is an absorbent pad in the bag. Leave it in the bag with the sample tube. Close the bag tightly.

Write the sample details on the last page of this form. Return the form to the laboratory together with the sample. The sample should preferably be delivered to the laboratory on the same day you collected the sample. If the delivery time becomes longer, please store the sample in the fridge.
